The 10th Mt. Fuji International Opera Competition of Shizuoka will be held in 2026!!

Commencing in 1996, the 50th year after the death of MIURA Tamaki, the Mt. Fuji International Opera Competition of Shizuoka is held once every three years in Hamamatsu City, to commemorate the world-famous prima donna, known for ties to Shizuoka Prefecture.

Outline of the Competition

Competition Period	Saturday November 14– Sunday November 22, 2026
Competition Venue	ACT City Hamamatsu Main Hall (Hamamatsu City, Shizuoka, JAPAN)
Application Qualifications	The Competition is open to applicants of all nationalities, however there is an age limit.
Adjudication	<div> <div>The 1st Round</div> <div>Contestants perform two arias with piano accompaniment. One is a self-chosen aria for the 1st round and the other is an aria designated by the Jury on their performance day from among the four proposed arias.</div> </div> <div> <div>The 2nd Round</div> <div>Contestants perform part(s) designated by the Jury from the whole opera of their self-chosen roles with piano accompaniment.</div> </div> <div> <div>The Final Round</div> <div>Contestants perform two arias with orchestral accompaniment. One is a self-chosen aria for the Final and the other is an aria designated by the Jury from among the four proposed arias.</div> </div>

* Two self-chosen arias, four proposed arias and one self-chosen role should be registered at the time of the application.

Competition Proceedings

Application	The announcement regarding the application guidelines for the 10th Competition is scheduled in September 2025.
Preliminary Audition	Applicants are selected based on submitted recordings.
Formal Application	Upon receipt of the acceptance notice of participation, applicants are required to complete the necessary procedures. Then their participation is officially approved.
Appearance in the Competition	Financial support for traveling is provided to contestants living outside Japan. Accommodations are provided for all contestants.*
Prizes	<p>Total Sum: ¥6,450,000- *</p> <p>(¥3,000,000 for the 1st Prize)*</p> <p>◎MIURA Tamaki Special Prize</p> <p>A special scholarship for the purpose of promoting education will be granted to a talented and promising contestant from among Japanese nationals.</p>
