Commencing in 1996, the 50th year after the death of MIURA Tamaki, the Mt. Fuji International Opera Competition of Shizuoka is held once every three years in Hamamatsu City, to commemorate the world-famous prima donna, known for ties to Shizuoka Prefecture.

The Competition is open to applicants of all nationalities, however there is an age limit.

Adjudication

The 1st Round

Contestants perform two arias with plano accompaniment. One is a self-chosen aria for the 1st round and the other is an aria designated by the Jury on their performance day from among the four proposed arias.

The 2nd Round

Contestants perform part(s) designated by the Jury from the whole opera of their self-chosen roles with plano accompaniment.


